Travel Sketching Pen and Wash

Monday 10th January 2022 – 9.30am – 4.45pm

You Need to Supply:

- jar (with lid) for water
- old hand towel
- lead pencils (2 x 3B)
- eraser
- ruler
- scrap paper for testing colours
- range of watercolour paints (tubes or pans are fine) – two reds, two blues, two yellows, two browns, one black, and a small tube of white gouache
- few small brushes, approx. size 4, 2, 0
- small paint palette (a travel palette is ideal but for this lesson, any palette will be fine)
- 300 gsm hot pressed paper (smooth) - about 6 x A5 sheets OR an A5 travel sketchbook
- black waterproof archival pens size 0.3 and 0.5 (from Officeworks or any art store – Artline or Uniball). I use a Uniball Eye fine pen.
- small fold-up chair (for if we go outside to sketch)
- bottle of water, hat, sunscreen, camera
- tissues
- small water spray bottle

No pre-drawing required. If weather permits, we'll go outside in the morning or afternoon to sketch our surroundings. If we stay inside, we'll sketch and paint from photographs which I'll provide.
