String, scissors, secateurs, Permanent marker pen, some safety pins, apron or old clothes, gloves, notebook and pen, minimum of three wooden dowels (approx. broomstick thickness) or heatproof PVC pipeto roll bundles on (maximum length 50 cms). Approx 3 metres of scrap fabric to use as dye blankets, preferably flannelette or French terry. Op shop flannelette sheets are perfect. Lots of leaves. Pegs, not essential but useful, a clothes airer. Students are encouraged to bring extra fabrics to print on if they wish
